Young people across America are struggling to thrive. Suicide is now the second leading cause of death for young people in Iowa & nationally. Stats indicate 2 out of every 10 young people (20%) have mental health issues.*

Youth of all identities suffer from increased rates of mental illness. Unfortunately, BIPOC, LGBTQ+, & female youth endure negative health outcomes at disproportionately higher rates than their peers.*


